Silotank recognises its operations directly impact on the natural and human environment and aims through its Environmental Policy to continually assess the environmental implications of its activities and will actively seek the co-operation of clients, sub-contractors, suppliers, and all its employees in minimising adverse effects. The Environmental Management System established by the Company is designed to comply with the requirements of the BS EN ISO 14001:2004 standard and is appropriate to the nature, scale and environmental impacts of all it activities.

The Company Managing Director will be responsible for ensuring that the system is implemented and maintained, the Company Environmental Manager will advise upon and audit the system and will report directly to the Silotank Board.

The Company will in the execution of contracts aim to comply with or exceed all environmental legislative requirements, regulations and standards of the Country in which it is operating. In the absence of any governmental legislation the Company will adopt internationally accepted environmental best practice.

The Company is committed to continual improvement in all aspects of its environmental performance. The Company is also committed to the prevention of pollution.

The Company will set establish environmental targets and objectives at Corporate level which will be implemented within each of the contracts. All targets and objectives will where possible be quantitative. The targets and objectives will be reviewed at least bi-annually or at least once per contract which ever is sooner and will be modified from time to time in order to effect a process of continual improvement. Targets and Objectives established will cover all aspects of the Company's activities and will ensure that all significant impacts are identified and measures taken to mitigate against them.

The Company will implement, maintain and will communicate this policy to all employees and will ensure that sub contractors used by the Company will be fully aware of this policy.

This policy will be made available to the public.
